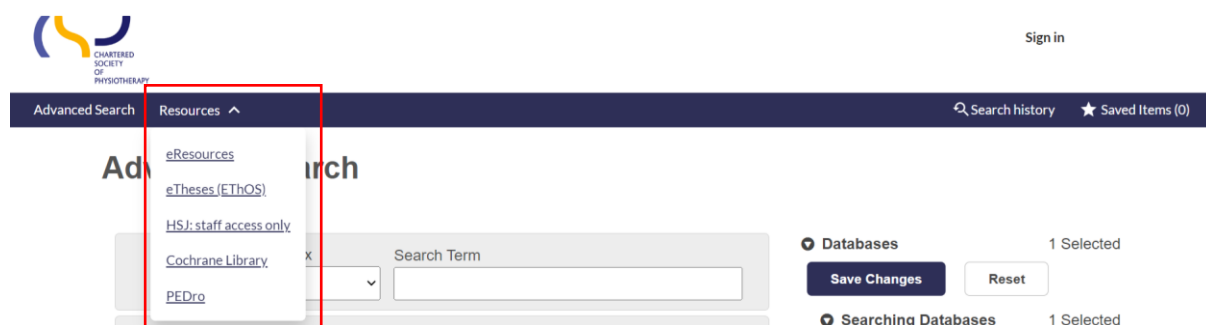


## Information skills: Searching WorldCat Discovery – October 2023

### Resources - Links to External Information Sources

Click on the Resources link to access the menu.



Link	Where does it search	Authentication required
<b>eResources</b>	List of A-Z titles: search or browse electronic resources only: Articles, eJournals, eBooks, eBooks citations, or Collections.	No login required to search the A-Z list. CSP login is needed to view full text.
<b>eTheses (ETHOS)</b>	Search over 600,000 doctoral theses in the British Library's EThOS database.	No login required to search the database. Free registration is required to download theses or to order a digitised copy.
<b>HSJ: staff access only</b>	HSJ journal website	Only staff who requested access can view full text articles.
<b>Cochrane Library</b>	Cochrane Library website	No login is required to browse Cochrane Reviews or search Trials. Free registration is

		required to save search strategies.
<b>PEDro</b>	PEDro, the Physiotherapy Evidence Database (produced by The Centre of Evidence-Based Physiotherapy at the School of Physiotherapy, University of Sydney) website.	No login is required. This database gives access to bibliographic details and abstracts of randomised controlled trials, systematic reviews and evidence-based clinical practice guidelines in physiotherapy.

## eResources

- Using the A-Z list allows you to connect to the full-text content the CSP's eLKAS subscribes to quickly.
- Search for Articles, eBooks, eBook citations and Journals.
- Browse subscription Collections and Journals.
